



2018 Thorevilos

NAPA VALLEY

Thorevilos was originally planted as a vineyard that would solely be a fruit source for other wineries. It took David about 10 years to finally take a few tons to see how the fruit can come together as a wine in his eyes. Now, Thorevilos is expanding and evolving into a true estate property, one that has clear vision and a true direction. 2018 marks the year when we began to expand and direct our attention towards the next thirty years.

We were able to harvest a small amount of fruit off the higher terraces of Cabernet as well as the half acre of Merlot before harvest was interrupted by rain on October 1. The highly porous and well drained volcanic ash soils dried out quickly so we were able to pick across all three of the Cabernet blocks to create an entire ferment of Cabernet Sauvignon on October 9. This became the building block of the 2018 Thorevilos wine. The last of the Cabernet came off on October 16 along with small amounts of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Finally, on October 20, the final component of the 2018 blend was complete with a tank of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. The 2018 Thorevilos is a blend of 61% Cabernet Sauvignon, 18% Cabernet Franc, 14% Petit Verdot and 7% Merlot.
