



2019 Thorevilos

NAPA VALLEY

With the purchase of 160 acres in the unnamed slopes east of St. Helena, the evolution and future of Thorevilos was realized in 2019. Staked with vines planted by David in 1992, this vintage marks the greatest of new beginnings. Expansion of the original 8 acres is nearly complete showcasing what is possible in these hidden hills. This current release, and subsequent vintages, are wines without boundaries, come with no apologies and embody the true character of Thorevilos.

Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon continue to lead the way into harvest at Thorevilos. The structure of Cabernet matches well with the round, full flavors of Merlot. As we saw in all vineyards in 2019, Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc progressed quickly and were combined on October 9. These two varieties help define the structure and provide energy in the blend. Picks on October 10, 12 and 15 all featured Cabernet Sauvignon from many different sections of the vineyard. The oldest Cabernet Sauvignon vines supplied the framework for the final blend that was enhanced by the drive and wild nature of Petit Verdot and Cabernet Franc. The 2019 Thorevilos is a blend of 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, 19% Cabernet Franc, 17% Petit Verdot and 9% Merlot.
